Easy Application Process

- 3. Personal Tour and learn about our program, tour our campus, and get answers, to your specific questions.
- 4. Schedule a comprehensive educational assessment on your child and submit a fee of \$100.00
- 5. Once applicant receives an Enrollment Letter, the parents will submit a required 2-month tuition deposit which is non-refundable.
- 6. Parent returns enrollment contract with required 2-month non-refundable deposit.
